The app's modern, user-centric, intuitive design makes it easy for any learner to quickly react to immediate needs and maintain active communication anytime, anywhere.

Product or Program Innovation

Simplicity of technology:

The Blackboard app was built to complement Blackboard Learn, a robust LMS with great breadth and depth of functionality. The Blackboard app makes it easy for professionals to stay connected to their learning environments, no matter where they are, and was specifically designed to facilitate key tasks leaners want and need to complete on the go. The app's simplified workflows are designed for smaller screens, focused on improved optimization and speed for the most commonly performed tasks and mobile activities, like quickly accessing content, completing courses and connecting with colleagues using Collaborate, a video conferencing tool built directly into the app. The app also leverages native mobile features like push notifications to surface key information to learners.

Advanced functionality:

The Blackboard app includes Blackboard Collaborate, a synchronous web-conferencing solution for high-quality virtual meetings. Facilitators or trainers can share files and video while interacting with the class, and participants can engage using a variety of different features right within the app. Users can set their status to *Away*, share video or voice, raise their hand, use the chat feature, share files and content, use whiteboard drawing tools or join breakout groups set by the moderator to complete smaller projects.

The Blackboard app was also built to be accessible for all users, regardless of age, ability or situation. It works with accessibility features built into iOS, Android and Windows devices, making the content available for people with physical, visual or hearing impairments. Accessibility features include screen reader functionality, zoom, color filters and visual settings, and accessible navigation tools (like Bluetooth or external hardware).



Unique Differentiators

Activity Stream: The activity stream provides learners with an up-to-the-minute list of important course activity including new content, announcements and grades in the Blackboard app. The activity stream automatically prioritizes the items to help learners focus on the tasks that they want to take care of right away. Learners can tap an item directly from the stream to open it and begin working. The stream will surface important items like organization alerts, course announcements, due dates and overdue assignments, grades and more.

Benefits of Mobile Learning:

- Quickly get information into the hands of employees: Employees today are
 extremely mobile and many travel frequently for work. This makes onsite faceto-face meetings and training more difficult. Mobile learning allows employees
 to quickly and easily disseminate materials at a moment's notice.
- Save time: Mobile learning can reduce the amount of time needed to dedicate to training by up to 50 percent.
 - Employees can choose to learn when and where they want to, without needing to wait for someone to deliver the material.
- **Drive employee engagement**: Mobile allows employees to participate in discussions or meetings and engage with coworkers no matter where they are.
 - When employee engagement increases, there is a corresponding increase in employee retention by up to 87%.
 - Employees are not at their desk roughly 50 to 60 percent of the scheduled workday.
